Instructions for Formatting and Uploading a

Call for Paper Proposal

for the CBAA 2012 Conference

PART 1: Creating Your Abstract

- 1. Open a new blank document in Microsoft Word.
- 2. Type your 250-word abstract.
 - a. Double check to make sure you did not include your name on this document.
- 3. Save the file with the file name as the title of your paper NOT your name.
 - a. Ex: LetterpressAndDigitalPrinting.docx

PART 2: Uploading the File to the Submission Manager

- 1. From the CBAA Conference Website (www.collegebookart.org), navigate to the Call for Paper Proposals.
- 2. Click the link to the submission manager. If you have never used our submission manager before, you will be prompted to create an account. Please follow the on-screen directions for creating a login profile. Once you've done that, you will be taken to the next step.
- 3. **UPLOADING YOUR FILE** → A page will appear that looks similar to the image below:

 - i. **Submission Title** –This box should NOT include your name. All entries are judged using an anonymous reading process. Type in the title of your proposal/paper.
 - 1. **Example**: Letterpress and Digital Printing
 - ii. **Upload Submission** Click BROWSE and UPLOAD to upload the file you created using the directions above.

iii. Cover Letter / Biography – This is the only box that should include your personal information. Our readers will not be able to see this section. So that we can match your file to your name, please be sure to include your full name in this section ONLY.
