



## **CBAA Distinguished Career Award**

By honoring outstanding educators, the CBAA reaffirms its mission to support the teaching of book arts at the college and university level. With this award, the CBAA seeks to honor an individual whose accomplishments continue to have a significant impact on the academic pursuit of book art.

**The CBAA Distinguished Career Award** will be awarded to an individual who continues to contribute significantly to the pedagogical development of the field by recognized teaching, lecturing, and/or administrative excellence, demonstrated by accomplishments that further the study of book art, innovative teaching or lecturing practices, high-quality student work, papers or presentations at national conferences, and/or other substantial contributions to the education of book artists and the advancement of the field.

### **Eligibility**

- Currently working full or part-time at an accredited undergraduate or graduate institution
- Must be a member of CBAA. For information: <http://www.collegebookart.org/membership.html>

### **Procedure**

Nominations must be in the form of two letters: one from a professional colleague or college administrator, the second from a former student. An individual may self-nominate, but the two letters (from colleague and a former student) are still required. Supporting letters must include, but are not limited to:

**From the nominator:** Reasons why you are nominating this person for the award, citing specific examples of contributions to the field, as described above.

**From the nominee:** A current curriculum vita or resume including documentation of honors, grants, exhibitions, publications, student accomplishments; course syllabi; and any other evidence/documentation that would give a fuller understanding of the nominee's work and practice.

**Form of submissions:** Letters and supporting materials must be sent in digital form, on a CD. Documents must be in pdf format; images in jpg, in separate folders, clearly labeled.
