



CBAA Emerging Educator Distinguished Teaching Award

By honoring outstanding educators, the CBAA reaffirms its mission to support the teaching of book arts at the college and university level. With this award, the CBAA seeks to honor emerging educators whose accomplishments have contributed to the advancement of the broad profession of the book arts.

The CBAA Emerging Educator Distinguished Teaching Award will be awarded to an emerging educator who has contributed significantly to the pedagogical development of the field by recognized teaching excellence, demonstrated through innovative teaching practices, high quality student work, papers or presentations at national conferences, and/or other substantial contributions to the education of book artists and the advancement of the field.

Eligibility

- Currently teaching full or part-time at an accredited undergraduate or graduate institution
- Completed studies within the last twelve years or began teaching within the past seven years
- Must be a member of CBAA. For information: <http://www.collegebookart.org/membership.html>
- Current CBAA board members are not eligible for consideration

Procedure

Nominations must be in the form of two letters: one from a professional colleague or college administrator, the second from a former student. An educator may self-nominate, but the two letters (from colleagues and a former student) are still required. Supporting letters must include, but are not limited to:

From the nominator: Reasons why you are nominating this person for the award, citing specific examples of contributions to the field, as described above.

From the nominee: A current curriculum vita or resume including documentation of honors, grants, exhibitions, publications, student accomplishments; course syllabi; and any other evidence/documentation that would give a fuller understanding of the nominee's work and practice.

Form of submissions: Letters and supporting materials must be sent in digital form, on a CD. Documents must be in pdf format; images in jpg, in separate folders, clearly labeled.
